intervention to bring it to an end. Help me to grow in holiness, for Your honor and glory, and for the welfare of my soul.

I come to You in all my necessities, in fear, but also in faith. Make me a worthy carrier of Your cross.

The Crucifixion and Death

We condemn others only because we want to avoid knowing ourselves.” When we gaze at our own failings, we see such a swamp that nothing in another can equal. That is why we turn away and focus on the faults of others. Instead of condemning others, may we strive to reach inner peace. Lord, help us to keep silent and to refrain from judgment. Shield our growing hearts against all evil.

Rom 2:1 – Therefore, you are without excuse, every one of you who passes judgment. For by the standard by which you judge another you condemn yourself.

Lk 12:3 – Therefore whatever you have said in the darkness will be heard in the light, and what you have whispered behind closed doors will be proclaimed on the housetops.

The Resurrection

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen

OUR FATHER:

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

HAIL MARY:
