piercing crown. These thorns were one and two inches in length. Using sticks as leverage, the soldiers wedged this crown of thorns into Your head. As they did so, Your blood poured and gushed forth, flowing into Your eyes... Oh Jesus, this makes me think of how I have sinned through the judgment of my mind and through what I have allowed my eyes to see.
